## **New Business:**

1. New Safe Environment Regulations July 1, 2024- Diocese has changed Virtus; there will be a refresher on line for applicable volunteers (every 5 years and a prompt will be sent). Adult altar servers will now be included in the applicable volunteers. There will now be background checks every year for the applicable adults. Fr. Michael will decide if other volunteers (ie, ushers, money counters) will be included.

## Old Business Update:

- 1. Review of constitution and by-laws we will try to consider the bylaws in sections. We are searching for a reasonable modification of the by-laws to reflect where this small, volunteer driven parish is today. The directive for each pc member is to compare current by-laws to Call to Serve, and come to next meeting prepared with opinion, questions.
  - A. First for consideration attendance; keeping in mind that ministries are seasonal, we would like to make attendance more positive, not punitive.
  - B. Quorum what should be the target number? Kevin Fallon has suggested changing to 6 for future meetings.
  - C. Elections we attempted the full election system last spring. We did not have an election (with such a small parish, the effort was great, but still did not meet the election regulations). Kevin has suggested following Call to Serve process, adapt to our parish, and adopt is (most significant is the term of service 3 years).

Discussion – questions about how tonight's discussion is different from last month (mainly, last month was wide open to all the by-laws and tonight we are targeting select areas to discern)

John McCormick gave some history for the reasons behind the bylaws (importantly, there would always be a rotation that allows for veteran and new members to overlap; so there will not be a brand new council, all at once)

Rob Harris has suggested a small group to examine and suggest changes. We will determine, after the large group approach, if this is a better way to go.
